Wedding Policies and Guidelines

St. Catherine's welcomes you to our marriage preparation process. We are pleased that you want to celebrate the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony in the Catholic Church and in the presence of the family of God who will support you in deepening matrimonial commitment.

The sacramental celebration of marriage is a public act of worship. Thus, the wedding liturgy must be in accordance with the liturgical guidelines set down by the universal church and Diocese of Des Moines.

We reverence and respect your wedding as a holy and sacred celebration

The wedding liturgy reflects the norms of the Catholic Church and the holiness of this Holy matrimony. The whole family of God (the church) rejoices and celebrates with you since your wedding liturgy is the sacramental celebration of your union and commitment.

We understand that since our core mission is student ministry there may be some of you who will participate in our wedding preparation procedure and celebrate your wedding in your home churches. Our office manager will assist you in planning for your wedding liturgy or preparation. We require that you contact our office manager 6-8 months prior to your intended wedding date.

This preparation process includes:

- ❖ **Initial interview with the priest or deacon**
 - ❖ **FOCCUS Inventory process**
 - ❖ **Natural Family Planning (NFP) Sessions**
 - ❖ **Marriage Preparation Course**
 - ❖ **Sacramental marriage preparation Retreats**
 - ❖ **Planning the wedding liturgy**
 - ❖ **Planning the wedding music**
 - ❖ **Final meeting with priest or deacon to review all necessary paperwork**
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- Weddings are scheduled on Saturdays between 10am and 3:00pm unless other reasons require another day or time.
 - It is essential that weddings and rehearsals begin on time.
 - Generally, rehearsals take place the evening before the wedding and need to be scheduled early in the planning process.

Parking: Per our fraternal agreement with Drake University there will be available parking space for your guests.

Fees: Our parish will spend a considerable amount of time and money helping you prepare for your marriage. Since our ministry is to college students, we encourage you to prayerfully consider the ministry at St. Catherine's when designing and planning your wedding budget. We encourage you to make donations to us before your wedding day or we submit your documents to your designated wedding church.

Celebration of Wedding

Donation Request for Weddings

A. When the wedding is celebrated at St. Catherine's

Parishioners - \$300.00

Students and Alumni of college/university within the Diocese of Des Moines- \$300.00

Non-Parishioners - \$500.00

Students of other college/university outside Des Moines Diocese - \$500.00

B. When the wedding is celebrated at a different parish but St. Catherine's does the preparation

Parishioners - \$150

Students and Alumni - \$200

Non-Parishioners - \$200

******A parishioner/student is defined as one who is registered with St. Catherine of Siena and offering tithes/contributions on a regular basis for at least one year before the first contact regarding the wedding is made with anyone on the staff.***

C. Musicians from St. Catherine's

Pianist – \$75.00

Cantor(s) - \$50.00 each

**You may arrange for you own musicians, in which you would need to negotiate a stipend directly with them.

documents Needed Prior to Wedding

A. Complete baptismal certificates for both the bride and groom.

For Catholics, the complete baptismal certificate should have notations on your first communion and confirmation.

B. Confirmation certificates for non-Catholics

For those who have been previously married

A. Former marriage certificate

B. Divorce decree

C. If applicable, documentation or proof of annulment
